(10 December 2004)

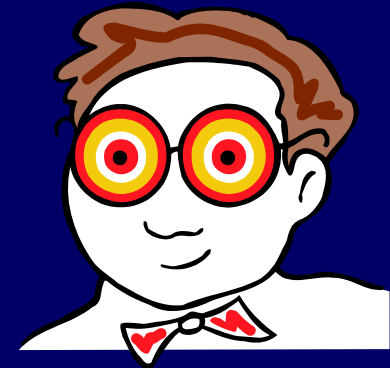


We decided

## In Particular :

- Define and implement the basic **quantitative** and **qualitative** requirements for European educational activities
  - to improve medical practice
  - to develop methods to show that better quality CME/CPD will produce quantifiable improvement in medical practice
  - to update & enhance how doctors apply their knowledge, skills and attitudes to improve their performance in their working lives
- Investigate, define and implement methods that would harmonize a compatible system of accreditation and awarding CME credits throughout Europe
  - to devise methods of supporting adult learning for individual pediatricians (in order to set their own personal learning agenda)
  - to set standards to ensure high quality CME/CPD and to promote models that are shown to work

## In Particular :

- Investigate methods of assessing the quality and responsibility of providers of relevant European pediatric societies
- Define the role of **EAP/CESP/rose...** and the implementation of a Pediatric CME accreditation committee
  - to set standards (methods of assessment) to ensure high quality CME/CPD and to promote and report on models that are shown to work
