Professor Helena Fonseca (Portugal) delivered lecture : Experiences from working with adolescent health in Portugal: Pre- and post-graduate training efforts of Health Care Professionals in the field of Adolescent Health. She introduced current status of the quality standards for medical education in the field of Adolescent Health. ; enable European health professionals to: adequately address and manage adolescent health needs, integrate health education and prevention in clinical care, collaborate with families, schools and communities, assume responsibility in advocacy; initiate and support the development of adolescent health multidisciplinary networks; support set-up international/national/regional courses. Cooperation with EuTEACH -*this* European Training in Effective Adolescent Care and Health – EuTEACH which courses are held in Lousanne. The World Health Organization GLOBAL published STANDARDS FOR QUALITY HEALTH-CARE SERVICES FOR ADOLESCENTS. According this standards we need to create Adolescent medicine and health training for residents in paediatrics.
