- Understand constitutional delay in growth and puberty
- · Understand the epidemiology, diagnosis and management of diabetes
- Understand the causes and management of precocious puberty, delayed
- puberty and ambiguous genitalia Understand the anatomy , physiology and pathophysiology of the thyroid, parathyroid and adrenal glands
- Understand calcium metabolism
- Understand the investigation of hypoglycaemia

Skills/competencies

- · Measuring height accurately at different ages, assessment of height velocity
- Assessing pubertal status (Tanner staging)
- Using centile and growth velocity charts
