



Minutes EAP Winter Meeting - Primary and Secondary Care Friday, 7 December, 2018|14:30-16:30

Chairs:

- 1. The agenda was approved.
- 2. The minutes of the Spring Meeting in Sofia, May 2018, were approved.
- 3. New country delegates: delegates from Spain, Portugal and Slovenia introduced themselves.
- 4. Stefano del Torso presented the final report of the MOCHA-project. The presentation will be published on the website.
- 5. Developmental dysplasia of the hip (DDH) in children a European study on diagnosis and treatment. Peter Altorjai reported on the meeting from the DDH group, that took place in September in Hungary. The presentation will be published on the website.
- 6. Minimal training requirements and requirement for the educational centers in primary care.

The 3 important questions from Sofia May 2018 were highlighted again by Jernej Zavrsnik:

- 1. As Primary Care paediatrics will require additional training (over and above that in the Common Trunk syllabus) then we need to decide whether we term that 'specialization' or give it a different name (such as 'higher training'). Whatever it is called it would entail at least 2 years of extra training.
- 2. We need to consider (although not necessarily decide) how we name this profession (primary care, community care...) and how it relates to 'general paediatrics'.
- 3. At present the format for training requirements that is required by UEMS must include discussion of the methods of assessment of trainees, trainers and training centres.

It was decided in Sofia that certain items should be added, such as training requirements, in order to be adopted by the UEMS.

Robert Ross Russell presented the details of the training requirements. Next steps should include:

- Collation of advice on training centre requirements
- Review of UEMS documentation
- Liaison with ECPCP
- Presentation at tertiary group meeting
- Approval by GA and UEMS
