Minutes from Primary and Secondary care working group Brussel Saturday, Dec 14th, 2013

Chairs: Shimon Barak and Björn Wettergren The attendance was 25 persons

- 1. Approval of the agenda
- 2. Approval of the minutes of the previous meeting in Jerusalem
- 3. Peter Altoraj gave a report on the ECPCP-meeting held in Santiago de Compostela in October 2103.
- 4. Report by Shimon Barak on ongoing efforts to strengthen the relationship between EAP and ECPCP with participation of the two EAP chairs in PSWG as non voting members in the EC of ECPCP and vice versa with participation from ECPCP with one representative participating as nonvoting member in the PSWG and one in the Tertiary Care Group.
- 5. Reports on current national topics where especially the current situation in France was highlighted by Francis Rubel. In France on national level plans exist focusing on a severe downsizing of primary care paediatricians in the country.
- 6. Report by Björn Wettergren on a Beijing seminar October 21th, 2013. There were four invited foreign speakers; Ingrid Wolfe and Mathew Thomsson from UK, Joseph Niegla from US and Björn Wettergren from Sweden. In China now there is a great need of building up paediatric competence within the primary care sector.
- 7. Primary and Secondary Care in the Barcelona meeting October 2014, Shimon Barak reported on a flower of different topics that will be dealt with linked to primary and secondary paediatric care
- 8. Manual of Primary Care Paediatrics, Shimon Barak presented reasons for producing such a manual and suggested that it should be a task within the framework of EAP. His suggestion was approved and it was decided that Shimon and Adamos will make a draft to be presented at the spring meeting in Poland in May 2014.
- 9. Stefano del Torso presented himself as he is applying for the vice presidency chair in the EC of EAP
- 10. Claude Billeau reported from a successful course this year in Bordeaux concerning teaching paediatrics to school teachers.
- 11. Definition of primary and secondary care. A discussion was brought up concerning the definitions of primary and secondary care. It was concluded that there is a need of revising this definitions and that this ought to be a task for further processing within EAP.
