busy discussion on Catch-Up Immunization Schedules espec. for adolescents; there will be further close cooperation with the adolescent working group to work out a general EU recommendation and guide lines;

Concerning vaccination of preterms the general WHO and EMEA recommendation were presented (up to week of pregnancy 28 the first vaccination should be at the hospital concerning apnea danger risk)

Recommendations for Prevention and Control of Influenza in Children: also in healthy children to prevent community transmission, to reduce transmission with in the households and widezr community as well as severe diseases and child deaths; there was a decision to work together with ESPID concerning this matter and provide common guidelines;

Mandatory vaccination programs – an advantage over voluntary policy was compared; a summary of the questionnaire will be edited and evaluated soon;

The problem with vaccination consent with minor parents for there children was brought up by the ethic group and references to this matter will be worked out;
