4.1. Updates on EAP Statutes

- a. The new EAP Statutes were approved on 27/10/2020
- b. Articles of the association were officially amended on: 31/12/2021
- c. The Royal decree confirmed the amendment of the EAP articles of association: 02/04/2021
- d. Publication of the new articles of association in the annexes of the Belgian State Gazette: 17/06/2021
- e. The new, inclusive EAP Statutes welcome individual members from all EAP's National Societies as automatic members of the EAP.
- f. EAP can be regarded as pan-European Association.
- g. The non-EU countries welcomed this change and thanked the EAP for its role in harmonizing the training, medical services across Europe and for being allowed to be under the umbrella of the EAP.
- h. The EAP welcomed all European countries to join the association as national members.

4.2 IPA

- a. The president elaborated on a closer collaboration between the International Paediatric Association (IPA) and the European Academy of Paediatrics (EAP).
- b. The audience was honoured to welcome Prof. Aman Pulugan, the Executive Director of IPA, who also attended the EAP Spring Meeting 2021 virtually, to the proceedings of the General Assembly.
- c. IPA EC unanimously decided to officially give the one of the two seats of Europe to the European Academy of Paediatrics.
- d. The decision was ratified unanimously by the standing committee of IPA.
- e. EAP officially represents the region of Europe.
- f. The Structure of IPA was elaborated: Executive Committee consists of 9 members; the Standing Committee consists of 21 members and the EC members; 6/7 Regions shall include the President plus one duly elected representative to represent Member National Pediatric Societies within their geographic region. Asia-Pacific region has 2 additional representatives elected by the CD. Therefore, regional representation accounts for 16 total seats on the SC. The remaining five seats are duly elected representatives of the Member International Pediatric Specialty Societies. 1 delegate per country can serv on the Council of Delegates. 4.3 Collaboration between ECPCP and EAP

- a. There were 2 joint statements between EAP and ECPCP that formed a part of a new collaboration.
- b. EAP and ECPCP statement Risks for children's health during the COVID-19 pandemic and a call for maintenance of essential pediatric services.
- c. SARS-CoV-2 vaccination in minors (children and adolescents) a joint statement of the European Academy of Paediatrics and the European Confederation for Primary Care Paediatricians
- d. The future of the collaboration entails the publication of more statements, running of a joint EAPRASnet study amongst others.

4.4 EU Projects

a. Core-MD

EAP Representative: Berthold Koletzko

Manufacturers of medical devices need to test their products before being allowed to market them. Specifically, they require clinical data showing their medical device is safe and efficient. In this context, the EU-funded CORE-MD project will translate expert scientific and clinical evidence on study designs for evaluating high-risk medical devices into advice for EU regulators.

EAP is a member of the Consortium running the EU Commission H2020 project entitled: Innovative Immunisation Hubs. The past year has highlighted that specific groups in European society have limited access to vaccines due to socioeconomic, cultural, geographic or health reasons. The Innovative Immunisation Hubs (ImmuHubs) project, which is designed to run for three years, has been set up in response to this. The project's aims are to: establish partnerships with citizen groups, public health agencies and the public to improve access for specific population groups in eight countries; create innovative immunisation actions to increase vaccine uptake; develop sustainable solutions for vaccine protection. Among the targeted countries are Cyprus, Greece, Finland, Portugal & Poland. Actions taken will be monitored and the project has quantifiable targets such as increasing the uptake of childhood vaccines by 10 percent.

The ImmuHubs Coordinator is Barbara Rath, MD PhD HDR, Co-founder & Chair, The Vienna Vaccine Safety Initiative.

c. RIVER-EU

EAP representatives: Stefano del Torso, Hans Juergen Dornbusch; Adamos Hadjipanayis, Yiannis Trimithiotis (Project Manager)

EAP is a member of the Consortium running the EU Commission H2020 Project entitled River-EU: Reducing inequalities in vaccine uptake in the European Region – Engaging Undeserved Communities.

The RIVER-EU project aims to tackle barriers in health systems for vaccine uptake among minority groups in Europe. The five-year project focuses specifically on the MMR and HPV vaccinations in selected communities (migrant community in Greece, Turkish females and Moroccan females in the Netherlands, Ukrainian minority in Poland and Roma community in Slovakia). The aims of the project include: to increase understanding of the reasons for low vaccine uptake in specific contexts; to develop strategies to increase vaccination rates in these contexts; to develop recommendations that other health authorities can implement. The RIVER-EU Coordinator is Danielle Jansen, Assistant professor of the Department of Health Sciences at University Medical Centre.

d. Immunion project

EAP representative : Stefano del Torso

EAP is a leading member of the Scientific Advisory Board for the Immunion project which aims to increase the uptake of vaccines by European citizens. The EAP is also leading the development of the SEKI education platform.

The Immunion project, designed by the Coalition for Vaccination, aims to improve immunisation cooperation in the EU. The project will notably strengthen joint efforts amongst Coalition for Vaccination member associations to improve the uptake of vaccines by European citizens. Specific objectives of Immunion include improving the dissemination of validated vaccination training materials and resources to health professionals across Europe; strengthening the Coalition for Vaccination; increasing training opportunities for health professionals and students on vaccination communication; enhancing collaboration with media on vaccination; understanding drivers of vaccine inequalities within countries.

UNICE ECARCO will develop campaigns concept and messages, which will be consulted with EAP; Develop a set of visual assets for each campaign, using testimonies (and images) of health workers and caregivers supporting vaccination; Implement the campaign using its regional social media platforms, and through rollout in countries in the region; Monitor and measure campaigns results on UNICEF platforms, based on social media analytics.

EAP will suggest, review, and provide inputs to social media campaigns concepts, key messages, and approaches; Collect and share testimonies from health workers and caregivers to support development of visual assets; Roll out the campaign through its social media platforms and networks; Monitor and measure campaigns results on EAP platforms, based on social media analytics.

- c. The EC will monitor the situation closely and the final decision will be made closer to the time in September/October 2021.

- a. The EAP/UEMS -SP has the following accounts:

- d. EAP has a PayPal/Stripe account in addition, which is used to collect fees for the online exam.
- e. The EAP is financially sound, despite the pandemic, with a slightly positive trend.
- f. This year the winter meeting was in January 2021 and the financial documents were uploaded on the EAP's website & presented to our external reviewers (Karin Geitmann & Artur Mazur).
- g. The total account balance slightly exceeds half a million EURO.
- h. The main income was from Congresses and Events.
- i. There was an educational grant from Abbot (sponsorship income)
- j. Membership income is mainly from National Societies.
- k. There are questions that will be raised for future considerations about how the income from National Societies will be split between the EBP & UEMS / EAP
- I. The income streams in 2019 & 2020 are considered stable and the stream of revenue is more balanced and sustainable than in the past.
- m. Main expenses over the past period were related to the Exam (especially Secretariat Services).
- n. There were comments regarding the founding of a research fund for EAP where young people can apply for funding. This will be discussed further by the Executive Meeting.
