## European Board of Paediatrics (EBP) MINUTES

- 1. Welcome and Apologies by the EBP chair, Liviana da Dalt
- i) The general assembly started at 09:00.
- 2. Approval of the final agenda
  - i) The agenda was approved without remarks.
- 3. Approval of the EBP Minutes, Spring Meeting 2022, Valletta, Malta, 14 May 2022
  - i) The minutes were approved without remarks.

### 4. Matters arising from the Minutes

i) No matters were discussed.

### 5. EBP/EAP Exam Update - Peter Hoyer (presentation available here)

- ii) This fourth pan-European knowledge-based examination took place on 22 November 2022; the first exam was held in October 2020.
- iii) The exams are based on the core training curriculum and are intended for trainees around 3 years into paediatric training.
- iv) The history and successful development of the exam and its many contributors were revisited.
- v) An update on the exam progress in 2022, including the question writing meeting that took place in July 2022 and work completed on the blueprint and questions were discussed. Several new topics were added, and others were removed (consult the presentation for details).
- vi) An in-person exam was held in a number of centres in the Netherlands and Italy in 2022 alongside the online examination.

### 6. EBP Learning Update - Francesca Seregni

- i) The EAP Education Working Group consists of the following members: Rob Ross Russell (UK), Francesca Seregni (UK), Liviana da Dalt (Italy), Debora Calderoni (UK), Kathy Gallagher (Ireland), Valentina Ferraro (Italy), Ana Lastovka (Belarus), Jose Lopez Guillen (Spain), Myat Win (UK).
- ii) The goals of the task force are:
  - Promote education and training across Europe
  - Provide learning resources to paediatric trainees across Europe
  - Fostering collaboration across different countries
  - Improve and Harmonise training and training resources across European countries
- iii) The Core Knowledge Course that took place in preparation for the EBP Exam was conducted online on 20 & 21 October 2022.
- iv) The course had a total of 127 attendees from 31 countries (vs 2021: 79 participants), of which 42 were chairs and presenters.

- v) The EAP Learning Application where learning cases are sold at a minimal fee is still going strong. 2 new sets of cases are ready for publication at the time of the meeting.
- vi) The popularity of EAP Learning is steadily increasing since 2020, but the intense review process and time-consuming work often seems like a heavy burden for the time-limited volunteers.

### 7. UEMS activities

### 7.1. UEMS Meeting

- i) UEMS Council Meeting in Athens took place from 8-10 October
- ii) Pierre-Andre Michaud represented EAP.

### 7.2 Multidisciplinary joint committees – presentation by Pierre Andre Michaud and Miguel Martins

- i) A new initiative, an MJC in Paediatric Palliative Care is underway.
- ii) The committee would like to address the gap in education and training in Palliative Care by heterogenous provision of care in Europe and increasing advocacy on the topic.
- iii) Main goals are to:
  - · Promote standards in PalliativeCare
  - · Promote education and training opportunities
  - · Promote knowledge and skills in ethical issues
- iv) Stakeholders and Experts in PPC from different countries involved are, so far UEMS Paediatric Session, UEMS Anesthesiology Session and external expert on PPC.
- v) Announcement of our intention to create an MJC in Paediatric Palliative Care (PPC) at the UEMS Fall Council in Athens was made by Pierre André Michaud.
- vi) The idea was generally well received by the UEMS Council but voted negatively, because UEMS thought a MJC in Palliative Care (MJC PC: combining paediatric and adult care) would be more adequate A discussion opened on this in the EBP GA, and the position of many present is that PPC should be separated from adult PC, similarly to other paediatric subspecialties.
- vii) However, given the position already expressed by the UEMS, a possible way forward could be that the goal now is to get adult sections of UEMS to support the creation of a MJC in Palliative Care on which at least one of the Chairs would be a Paediatrician (hopefully an expert in PPC), which would insure that PPC agenda is on point.
- viii) Next steps: contact UEMS sections to ask for support on how to proceed.
- ix) At the end of the discussion Pierre Andre gives a brief update on MJC in Adolescent Medicine. The full presentation delivered is available here.
