

## **Engagement with non-State actors: accreditation and triennial review of regional non-State actors not in official relations with WHO to attend meetings of the WHO Regional Committee for Europe**

### **Draft decision**

The Regional Committee,

(PP1) Having examined the report on Engagement with non-State actors: accreditation and triennial review of regional non-State actors not in official relations with WHO to attend meetings of the WHO Regional Committee for Europe;<sup>1</sup>

(OP1) DECIDES, in line with the Framework of Engagement with Non-State Actors,<sup>2</sup> to grant accreditation status to the following non-State actors:

- (a) The European Academy of Paediatrics (EAP)
- (b) The European Hospital and Healthcare Employers' Association (HOSPEEM)
- (c) The European Specialist Nurses Organisation (ESNO)
- (d) The International Association of Mutual Benefit Societies (AIM);

(OP2) DECIDES to renew the accreditation status of the following non-State actors:

- (a) AFEW International
- (b) AGE Platform Europe
- (c) AIDS Healthcare Foundation (AHF) Europe
